Romeys Gin List

Avva Scottish Gin 43% ABV Scotland

4.70

Launched in late 2016 by the Elgin-based Moray Distillery (founded by Jill Brown, who previously founded the Berry Good range of liqueurs), Avva Scottish Gin is made using a combination of classic gin botanicals as well as botanicals foraged in Speyside and the Highlands. These include dandelion, mint, red clover, nettle and Rowan berries.

Agnes Arber 41.6% ABV England

4.10

The savoury, earthy notes of juniper, coriander, and angelica are complemented by the warm, spicy undertones of cassia; sweet, acidic flavours of lemon, lime, orange and grapefruit combine with an interesting twist of liquorice.

Bedrock Gin 40% ABV England Cumbria

4.00

Bedrock Gin is inspired by the ruggedly beautiful landscape of the Lake District, produced by Spirit of the lakes. This London dry gin is made using botanicals including juniper, orange, lemon, cinnamon, liquorice, angelica and kiln-dried oak bark from the Lake District.

Bedrock Export Strength 46% ABV England Cumbria

4.70

Retaining all the wonderful satin smooth flow of Bedrock (40%) the Export Strength version (46%) adds a fuller botanical experience where the juniper arrives a little later but lasts longer on the palate.

Bedrock Export Strength is a stronger London Dry gin made with spring water from the western Lake District. This 46% bottling highlights the subtle juniper and citrus elements for which their gin is renowned.

Berliner Brandstifer 40% ABV Berlin Germany

5.30

Dry Gin from Berlin that seeks to bring a summer's day in this German city and its immediate surroundings to your glass wherever you may be! Elderflower, woodruff and sweet blossoms combine in what remains a classically styled dry gin.

Black Tomato Gin 42.3% ABV Bruinisse Holland

4.40

Produced in the Netherlands, Black Tomato Gin is made using black Tomatoes as well as a few drops of sea water! Shows off a fascinating balance between sweet and savoury flavours - and ought to be excellent in a Red Snapper.

Boë Violet Gin 41.5% ABV Throsk Scotland

4.10

A vibrant variation on the Boë Gin recipe, which has been infused with violets! Surely an excellent tippie for the summer months, this will go well in a classic G&T with a vivid colour and hugely floral taste, with classic citrus-forward notes cutting through cleanly

Boë Peach and Hibiscus Liqueur 20% ABV Throsk Scotland
3.70

A fragrant gin-based liqueur from the Boë selection, showing off flavours of peach and hibiscus. Flavours of violet petals, juicy plum and a hint of coriander leaf, with an underlying notes of juniper and melon

Boë Scottish Bramble Liqueur 20% ABV Throsk Scotland
3.70

A fruit-forward gin-based liqueur from Boë, which ought to be quite useful in cocktails and general summer drink deliciousness. Flavours of sweet raspberries and blackberries, with light touches of iris and black pepper

Boë Superior Gin 41.5% ABV Throsk Scotland
4.10

Boë Superior Gin is named after and inspired by Franz de la Boë, who first created gin back in 1658 (originally intended as a medicine, not as a delicious libation as we enjoy it these days). Not only does this edition have a new ABV of 41.5%, it's also got a new recipe featuring some different botanicals, resulting in a vibrant flavour profile.

Broken Heart Gin 40% ABV New Zealand
5.60

A gin developed by two Germans living in New Zealand who grew to become good friends. One of them then tragically became ill and died, however, leaving the other to share the gin with the world alone. The name is heart-wrenchingly appropriate, but we're reminded that all ends come with new beginnings, with this gin representing those "moments of in-between".

Buss No. 509 Raspberry Gin 37.5% ABV Belgium
5.00

The first gin released from the Buss No.509 gin range. This Belgian gin features Juniper, Coriander, liquorice, Angelica, Vanilla, Cardamom, Iris, Orange, Lemon and Raspberry as botanicals. Though from the rosy hue you might expect it to be overtly sweet and fruit-filled, but the raspberry is actually rather well balanced alongside the juniper and assortment of other herbs, spices and citrus.

Deaths Door Gin 47% ABV Washington Island USA
5.70

A fantastic American gin for all your martini needs. Death's Door Gin is made with a base spirit of wheat from Washington Island and malted barley from Wisconsin, as well as a small selection of botanicals (juniper, coriander and fennel), and is bottled at a robust 47% ABV. Big but balanced notes of all three botanicals appear clear as day, carried on a clean, creamy spirit.

Dorothy Parker American Gin 44% ABV New York USA
3.90

Superbly bright, effortlessly cool and very popular with cocktail lovers. We're of course talking about Dorothy Parker, the legendary writer, poet and satirist, as well as talking about the New York Distilling Company's Dorothy Parker Gin! A spectacular American gin, made with traditional and contemporary botanicals including juniper, elderberries, citrus, cinnamon, and Hibiscus Petals. Simply marvellous in G&Ts, martinis, aviations and all manner of gin-based cocktails...

Dutch Courage Old Tom Dry Gin 40% ABV Baarle-Nassau Netherlands
4.30

A sweet, flavourful Old Tom Gin from Zuidam's Dutch Courage series, made with juniper, sweet orange, fresh whole lemons, coriander, angelica, liquorice, whole vanilla beans, elderflower and iris root. It's then set aside to age in American oak barrels for a short while before bottling. Also, it has a rather daring-looking cat wearing a moustache, monocle and a top hat on the label. Which is rad.

Edinburgh Rhubarb and Ginger Gin Liqueur 20% ABV Scotland
2.70

A warming rhubarb and ginger liqueur from the chaps at Edinburgh Gin. It captures a fine balance between the intense rush of ginger spice and the evocative, almost nostalgic sweetness of rhubarb, (we all feel nostalgic for rhubarb crumble, right? It's not just me?) as well as some classic juniper hints deeper within.

Farmer's Small Batch American Gin 46.7% ABV New York USA
5.20

Named in honour of the four farmers whose organic crops are used to create it, Farmer's Gin is certified organic by the USDA. The botanicals used include juniper, angelica, coriander, lemongrass and elderflower.

Few American Gin 40% ABV Chicago USA
5.00

Unlike any other gin, this offering from FEW Spirits is made using white whiskey (un-aged Bourbon) instead of more conventional neutral spirits which gives it a completely unique character! FEW Spirits hails from Evanston in the United States of America, a city that suffered Prohibition for over one hundred years thanks to many of its advocates hailing from its dry streets. Thankfully Evanston is now home to this excellent craft distillery which takes its name ironically from the initials of Frances Elizabeth Willard, a key figure in the Temperance Movement.

Haymans Family Reserve Gin Essex England
4.00

Hayman's Family Reserve harks back to the heady days of Gin Palaces, where the juniper-based libation would be sold from oak casks. This expressions from the tasty Hayman's Gin range has been rested in Scotch whisky casks for three weeks before bottling, which has imparted fragrant notes of oak and a softer mouth feel to the gin. There's also more herbal, peppery spice than other Hayman's Gins, which are often quite citrus-forward.

J.J Whitley Elderflower Gin 38.6%ABV England Warrington
4.30

JJ Whitley Elderflower Gin delicious, sweet and summery expression dominated by the unmistakable essence of elderflower with accents of orange blossom, honey and fresh green grass.

J.J Whitley London Dry Gin 38.6%ABV England Warrington
4.30

JJ Whitley Gin is made with just eight botanicals to create a classically-juniper forward London dry gin. Smooth and creamy, with fresh citrus to back up the peppery juniper, this is a great gin for martinis or to partner with tonic and lemon peel.

J.J Whitley Nettle Gin 38.6%ABV England Warrington
4.30

JJ Whitley Nettle Gin is a deliciously herbaceous gin that makes a fantastic, fresh and unique G&T with a herby kick. Expect notes of chopped basil, oily juniper, crushed coriander, forest floor and a subtle spark of citrus peels.

Kirkjuvagr Orkney Gin 43% ABV Elgin Scotland
4.60

An 'unmistakably Orcadian' gin made with locally grown botanicals including Ramanas Rose, Burnet Rose, Angelica and Borage. The inclusion of Angelica was inspired by a story that suggested Angelica was brought to the Orkney islands by Norsemen, and can still be found growing there..

Lakes Explorer Gin 47.1% ABV Cumbria England

4.80

Explore a limited edition gin from the Lakes Distillery in Cumbria! Their Lakes Gin Explorer Edition is made using a selection of 15 botanicals as well as 5 botanicals which are native to the Lake District National Park (it's also got Cumbrian juniper!). The ABV has been bumped up to 47.1% ABV, too.

Lakes Rhubarb and Rosehip Liqueur 25% ABV Cumbria England

3.80

The Lakes Rhubarb and Rosehip Gin Liqueur is the perfect balance derived from the Lakes Gin, with a layer of Rhubarb and the fruit of the Rose. A blend of provenance and distinctive style.

Langtons No1. 40% ABV Cumbria England

3.60

Langtons gin uses water filtered through ancient slate beneath the mountain of Skiddaw in the Lake District. Utilising Lakeland ingredients such as local oak bark blend where possible, a total of 11 botanicals are used with distillation taking place at Greenall's in Warrington. The bottle, which is also made in the north of England, reflects the contours of Skiddaw and the layers of slate from the all important aquifer.

Le Gin de Christian Drouin 42% ABV Normandy France

3.70

The only Gin incorporating 30 apple varieties and 8 different aromatics. Each aromatic is separately distilled before being blended in proportions that are unique to each batch.

Masons Yorkshire Tea Edition 42% ABV England

3.50

From the Masons Dry Yorkshire Gin range comes a gin with a rather familiar flavour to it - this one is focused on the scrummy, subtly aromatic notes of Yorkshire tea!

McQueen Sweet Citrus Gin 42% Stirling Scotland

5.10

An abundance of refreshing citrus-y gorgeousness resides within the McQueen Sweet Citrus Gin, produced up in Callandar, Scotland.

You're greeted immediately with zesty lemon and orange, followed by tart grapefruit and an underlying hint of vanilla.

Monkey 47 47% ABV Black Forest Germany

6.40

An unusual gin from the Black Forest in Germany, Monkey 47 contains a unique ingredient. No, not that! Cranberries! The 47 comes from the number of botanicals that go into this unique gin, and the fact it's bottled at a healthy 47%.

Nginious! Swiss Blended Gin 45% ABV Switzerland

7.80

Nginious! is a Swiss gin created by Oliver Ullrich and Ralph Villiger, made with a selection of 18 botanicals that have been placed into four groups, which have been distilled and blended together to produce the final spirit. The herbs chosen for Nginious! are native to Switzerland and include clover blossom, blackcurrant leaves, bee balm and more. Beautifully presented, too.

Nordés Gin 40% ABV Galicia Spain

4.00

Nordés Atlantic Galician Gin is a rather intriguing Spanish gin made with an Albariño-grape-based spirit, rather than your more commonly seen grain-based spirit, along with 12 botanicals including lemon peels, hibiscus, liquorice and eucalyptus. The result is a bold, floral flavour profile that would befit summer drinks and cocktails. The bottle is quite stylish too - very impressive stuff!

Pickering's Gin 42% ABV Edinburgh Scotland

3.40

Made at the first distillery to open in Edinburgh for 150 years: Summerhill. Made to an original Bombay recipe which had remained secret for more than 65 years, this is an aromatic gin with hints of nuts, liquorice and cinnamon.

Polugar No 10 Juniper Old Russian Gin 38.5% ABV Poland

7.30

Fascinating Russian gin from Polugar, whom are specialists in vodkas boasting intriguing flavour profiles. Featuring a base spirit of rye and wheat, this is a juniper-forward expression with particularly prominent berry sweetness in support.

Puerto de Indias Black Edition Dry Gin 40% ABV Seville Spain

4.60

Puerto de Indias Black Edition is made with citrus, jasmine and vanilla for creating more floral G&Ts. This edition is bottled at the slightly ABV of 40% (their classic edition is bottled at 37.5% ABV).

Rubbens Poppies Gin 40% ABV Zele Belgium

4.40

Poppies Gin comes to us via Belgium's family-owned Rubbens distillery, which has been producing jenever since the early 1800s! The legend behind this expression is that the recipe was created by an English soldier who took part in the First World War, hence the name.

Scapegrace Goldilocks Dry Gin 57% ABV New Zealand

6.40

A higher-strength variation on the Scapegrace Gin recipe, made in New Zealand using 12 botanicals (juniper, coriander, nutmeg, cardamom, lemon peel, orange peel, orris, cinnamon, cassia, angelica, clove and liquorice). However, for this edition, they also add some tangerine peels to the mix!

Sir Robin of Locksley Gin 40.5% ABV England

3.50

Sir Robin of Locksley Gin comes to us all the way from Sheffield, boasting a radiant flavour profile thanks to the botanical selection, which includes elderflower, dandelion and pink grapefruit. The name is a reference to local legend, Robin Hood!

Sharish Blue Magic 40% ABV Portugal

5.80

A bright blue Portuguese gin from the Sharish range - the magnificent colour comes from extracts of a flower known as blue pea, and when you mix the gin with tonic, it turns pink! Botanicals also include juniper, coriander, angelica root, ginger, cinnamon, cardamom, lemon peel, strawberry and raspberry.

Tarquin's British Blackberry 38% ABV England Cornwall

4.30

Tarquin's Brilliantly British Blackberry Gin, with a touch of local Cornish Wildflower Honey, is the latest addition to the Cornish distillery's award-winning portfolio of spirits.

With low sugar content, but a relatively high ABV of 38%, this is a gin that proudly celebrates the great British berry and the result is something really quite special.

Whitley Neill Quince Gin 43% England Warrington

4.30

This edition of Whitley Neill gin has been flavoured with quince juice and uses baobab as one of its botanicals. An exotic gin that will add extra fruitiness to a classic G&T. Flavours of coriander seeds, orange and lemon.

X-Gin Belgium Gin 46% ABV Roeselare Belgium

6.00

X-Gin is an intriguingly flavoured gin from Belgium, made with juniper and a whole host of other botanicals, many of which you might find in some indulgent chocolates. This includes Colombian cocoa beans, Piedmonte hazelnuts, Avola almonds, vanilla pods, wild chillies and more...

Xellent Edelweiss Gin 40% ABV Willisau Switzerland

5.20

A Swiss gin, made with a base of high-quality rye grain spirit, seasoned with 25 botanicals including Edelweiss, woodruff, elderflower, lemon balm and lavender - the latter two are grown by Master Distiller Franz Huber himself! It's diluted down to 40% using pure glacier water from the heart of Switzerland. A highly fragrant, refreshing and herbal gin, very suited to enjoying neat.

All product on this list are served in multiples of 25ml with a maximum of 50ml served in any one glass
